### How to Develop Close Relationships



Matthew 11:28-30

*Come unto me, all [ye] that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke [is] easy, and my burden is light.*

Jesus tells us the way to get rest when we are weary is to put on His yoke. We think the way to get rest is through leisure but Jesus teaches it is through working with Him. This is also the way you learn about Him. The quickest way to get to know someone is to share a yoke with them.

Many people have a strong desire to be close to someone but don't know how to do it. Let me share some ways.

- 1, Those who know me best are those who carry my yoke. The men who work with me have been through tough times with me. We are not golfing buddies we are working buddies.
2. If you have no friends it is because you carry no one's yoke. Shared work makes friends.
3. A friendship based on fellowship will not last.
4. Wanting to be with a person is selfish, but wanting to carry a person's yoke is unselfish.
5. Sharing a yoke requires closeness. There is no way two mules can plow together without being close.
6. Intimacy is caused by the emotional enjoyment of carrying the same yoke.

Those who strive together towards a goal will enjoy a closeness that those who fellowship together will never know.

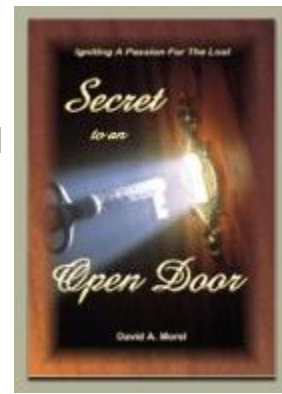

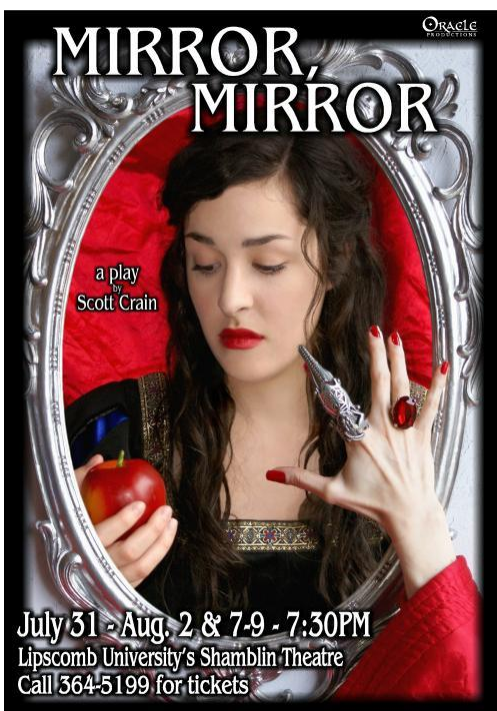


## Father & Son Fishing Trip
